**PUBLIC HEARING CONSIDERING THE ANNEXATION OF A PROPOSED TRACT OF LAND DESCRIBED AS APPROXIMATELY 140 ACRE TRACT ALONG THE NORTH AND SOUTH SIDES OF INTERSTATE 30 EAST OF THE CURRENT CITY LIMITS.**
