Press Release Commercial Business Burglary Arrest

On Sunday July 21st at around 10 PM Mount Pleasant Police officers responded to a suspicious persons call at 1115 N. Edwards, Lujo's Salon. When the first officer arrived, he found the front door to the salon slightly open. While the officer was waiting for other officers to arrive and assist with a search of the business, a Hispanic male came out the front door of the salon carrying a television.

When the officer confronted the burglar, the suspect threw the television at him striking and injuring the officer. The suspect then ran from police but he was captured a short time later in a nearby neighborhood. The burglary suspect was identified as 23-year-old Cliofa "Cliff" Delacruz of Mount Pleasant.

Delacruz was charged with numerous offenses related to this incident. Bail was set early Monday afternoon for the following charges:

- Assault of a Public Servant \$25,000 bail
- Burglary of a Building \$25,000 bail
- Evading Arrest \$2,500 bail
- Resisting Arrest \$2,500 bail
- Possession of Drug Paraphernalia (pending)
