Who can get the vaccine now?

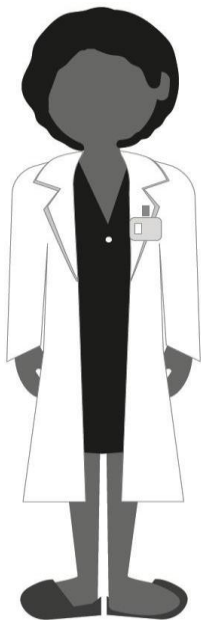
Anyone over the age of 16

Vaccines Available

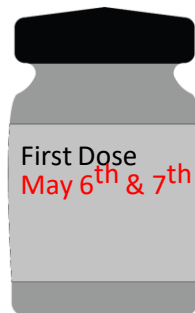
Pfizer: 1st and 2nd doses

Moderna: 2nd Dose only

Johnson & Johnson: Limited supply



The **Pfizer** COVID-19 vaccine is for those 16 years of age or older and requires two doses.



Why should I get the COVID-19 vaccine?

- Keep you and your family safe.
- Prevent more illness and death.
- Help get your community back to normal.



What else should I know?

- ✓ The vaccine gives you up to 95% protection from COVID-19 1-2 weeks after your second dose.
- ✓ We're still learning if vaccinated people can spread the virus.
- ✓ Continue to wear a mask, stay 6 feet apart, wash hands often and take all steps to stop COVID-19.
- ✓ Mild side effects are normal signs your body is building protection and usually go away after a few days.
- ✓ The chance of a severe reaction is less than 0.5%. There's no evidence that vaccines cause long-term health problems.
